

## **CV Claudia Voelcker-Rehage**

Prof. Dr. Claudia Voelcker-Rehage leads the professorship for Neuromotorics and Training at WWU Münster since November 2019. Previously, she was a professor of sports psychology (with a focus on prevention and rehabilitation) at TU Chemnitz. She received her PhD from the University of Bielefeld in 2002 and was subsequently a postdoctoral fellow at the Georgia Institute of Technology, USA (2003) and at the International University Bremen. From 2007, she was a lecturer at Jacobs University Bremen, where she was appointed Professor of Human Performance at the Jacobs Center on Lifelong Learning in 2010. Claudia Voelcker-Rehage was Managing Editor (Deputy) of the German Journal of Exercise and Sport Research for 10 years and Vice President of asp for eight years. She is also a Review Editor at Frontiers in Movement Science and on the Editorial Board of European Review of Aging and Physical Activity, Brain Sciences, OBM Geriatrics, and Psychology of Sport and Exercise. Her research interests include the neurocognition of movement, learning and plasticity, and the role of physical activity in cognitive development and health. To this end, she studies children and adolescents as well as age and aging in particular.
